25	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
26	Section 1. Sections 32-5B-5 and 32-5B-8 of the Code
27	of Alahama 1975 are amended to read as follows:

1 "\\$32-5B-5.

"Any person violating the provisions of this chapter

may shall be fined up to \$25.00 one hundred dollars (\$100).

The violation of the provisions of this chapter shall not

constitute probable cause for search of the vehicle involved.

"§32-5B-8.

"(a) A person subject to a penalty pursuant to Section 32-5B-5, shall not be assessed court costs on a conviction.

"(b) (1) In any case brought by a law enforcement officer employed by the Department of Public Safety, sixty

Alabama State Law Enforcement Agency, twenty-five dollars

(\$25) of each fine shall be distributed as follows: 60 percent (60%) of the funds generated shall be allocated to the Department of Public Safety, Law Enforcement Division. The Alabama State Law Enforcement Agency and the remaining forty

40 percent (40%) of the funds shall be allocated to the State General Fund.

"(2) Seventy-five dollars (\$75) of each fine shall be distributed as follows: The first one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) collected each fiscal year shall be allocated on an annual basis to the Alabama State Law Enforcement Agency for safety belt education and the remainder collected each fiscal year shall be allocated to the Alabama State Law Enforcement Agency for law enforcement purposes.

"(c) A law enforcement officer may not search or 1 2 inspect a motor vehicle, its content, the driver, or a passenger solely because of a violation of this chapter. 3 "(d) Each state, county, and municipal police 4 5 department must maintain statistical information on traffic 6 stops of this nature on minorities and report that information 7 monthly to the Department of Public Safety and the Attorney General." 8 9

Section 2. This act shall become effective on October 1, 2017, following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.

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
