13 Relating to Chilton County; to further provide for  
14 the qualifications and salary of the judge of probate.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

16 Section 1. (a) This act shall apply only in Chilton  
17 County.

18 (b) Upon the effective date of this act, in addition  
19 to any other qualifications required by law, a person  
20 qualifying for election to the office of the judge of probate  
21 in the county or a person appointed to serve as the judge of  
22 probate in the county shall meet all of the following  
23 additional criteria prior to his or her qualification or  
24 appointment:

25 (1) The person is a citizen of the United States.

26 (2) The person has been a resident of the county for  
27 at least one year.

1                   (3) The person qualifies as an elector pursuant to  
2 state and federal law and the person has been registered to  
3 vote in the county for at least one year.

4                   (4) The person has been awarded a four-year  
5 postsecondary degree or has completed three years of United  
6 States military service with honorable discharge.

7                   (5) The person is 25 years of age or older.

8                   (6) The person has never been convicted of a felony.

9                   (c) Effective at the commencement of the next term  
10 of office, the annual salary for the judge of probate shall be  
11 increased to seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000).

12                   Section 2. This act shall become effective  
13 immediately following its passage and approval by the  
14 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
