- (4) The person has been awarded a four-year postsecondary degree or has completed three years of United States military service with honorable discharge.
 - (5) The person is 25 years of age or older.
 - (6) The person has never been convicted of a felony.
- (c) Effective at the commencement of the next term of office, the annual salary for the judge of probate shall be increased to seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000).

Section 2. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
