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23		A BILL
24		TO BE ENTITLED
25		AN ACT
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To amend Section 16-4-1, Code of Alabama 1975, relating to the qualifications of the State Superintendent of Education; to require a candidate for appointment to hold an Alabama certificate in administration and supervision, have at least five years of experience in public school work, and provide proof to the State Board of Education of at least three years of successful educational experience during the five years next preceding appointment and a degree from a recognized four-year college or university.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Section 16-4-1 of the Code of Alabama 1975, is amended to read as follows:

"\$16-4-1.

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"(a) As the chief executive officer of the State Department of Education there shall be a State Superintendent of Education, who shall be appointed by the State Board of Education and shall serve at the pleasure of the State Board of Education; provided, however that the State Board of Education may enter into a contract with the State Superintendent of Education for his or her services for a period not to exceed four years.

"(b) The State Superintendent of Education shall be a person of good moral character, with academic and professional education equivalent to graduation from a standard university or college, who is knowledgeable in school administration and has training and experience sufficient to qualify him to perform the duties of his office. chosen for

1	his or her general fitness and character and shall be a person	
2	of recognized ability as a school administrator. No person	
3	shall be eligible for appointment by the State Board of	
4	Education unless he or she satisfies all of the following	
5	qualifications:	
6	"(1) Holds an Alabama certificate in administration	
7	and supervision based upon requirements established by the	
8	State Board of Education for the certificate.	
9	"(2) Has had not less than five years of experience	
10	in public school work at the time he or she assumes office.	
11	"(3) Submits proof to the board of at least three	
12	years of successful educational experience as a teacher,	
13	principal, supervisor, superintendent, educational	
14	administrator, or instructor in school administration during	
15	the five years next preceding appointment.	
16	"(4) Submits proof to the board that he or she holds	
17	a degree from a recognized four-year college or university.	
18	"(5) Submits proof to the board that he or she is	
19	knowledgeable in school administration.	
20	"(c) The salary of the State Superintendent of	
21	Education shall be such amount per annum as shall be set by	
22	the State Board of Education in an amount within the range now	
23	or hereafter established by law, to be paid in installments	
24	from the annual appropriation of the State Department of	
25	Education."	

Section 2. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
