Section 1. Section 31-12-2 of the Code of Alabama
1975, is amended to read as follows:

"§31-12-2.

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"Whenever any active member of the Alabama National 4 5 Guard, or a member of the national guard of another state who is employed in this state, in time of war, armed conflict, or 6 7 emergency proclaimed by the Governor or by the President of 8 the United States, shall be called or ordered to state active 9 duty for a period of 30 consecutive days or more or federally 10 funded duty for other than training, the provisions of the SSCRA federal Servicemembers Civil Relief Act (SCRA) and the 11 12 federal Uniformed Services Employment and Reemployment Rights 13 Act shall apply."

14 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the 15 first day of the third month following its passage and 16 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
