Section 1. The following amendment to Section 6.10 5 of Amendment 328 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now 6 appearing as Section 149 of the Official Recompilation of the 7 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, is proposed and 8 shall become valid as a part thereof when approved by a 9 10 majority of the qualified electors voting thereon and in accordance with Sections 284, 285, and 287 of the Constitution 11 12 of Alabama of 1901, as amended:

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

14 "§6.10.

"The chief justice of the supreme court shall be the 15 16 administrative head of the judicial system. He shall appoint 17 an administrative director of courts and other needed personnel to assist him with his administrative tasks. The 18 19 chief justice may assign appellate justices and judges to any 20 appellate court for temporary service and trial judges, supernumerary justices and judges, and retired trial judges 21 22 and retired appellate judges for temporary service in any 23 court. Commencing with the term of office beginning in January 24 2019, the Director of the Administrative Office of Courts 25 shall be appointed by a majority vote of the Justices of the 26 Alabama Supreme Court and shall serve a term of 12 years. The 27 Director of the Administrative Office of Courts may be removed

by a majority vote of the Justices of the Alabama Supreme 1 2 Court. Adequate and reasonable financing for the entire unified judicial system shall be provided. Adequate and 3 4 reasonable appropriations shall be made by the legislature for 5 the entire unified judicial system, exclusive of probate courts and municipal courts. An election upon the proposed amendment 11 shall be held in accordance with Sections 284 and 285 of the 12 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Sections 284 13 and 285 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of 14 Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this 15 state.

Section 3. The appropriate election official shall assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the following description of the substance or subject matter of the proposed constitutional amendment:
