24	apply:
25	(1) The defendant qualifies for a pretrial diversion
26	program, mental health court, drug court, veteran court, or
27	similar program.

1 (2) The county district or circuit court offers a 2 pretrial diversion program, mental health court, drug court, 3 veteran court, or similar program.

- (3) The municipal court does not offer a pretrial diversion program, mental health court, drug court, veteran court, or similar program.
- (b) A case so transferred shall become the exclusive jurisdiction of the district and circuit courts, and shall be prosecuted under the state law charged by the municipality.
- (c) The municipal court and the defendant shall each retain the right to object to any such transfer. Upon such objection the case shall not be transferred.

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
