13 Relating to Russell County; to create the Russell
14 County Sheriff Service of Process Fund; to further provide for
15 service of process in the county; to provide that the sheriff
16 may contract with or enter into agreement with a private,
17 public, or governmental entity for the purpose of service of
18 process; to set the fee for civil documents with certain
19 exceptions; and to provide for the disposition of funds.
20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

21 Section 1. (a) This section shall apply only to
22 Russell County.

23 (b) The Russell County Sheriff Service of Process
24 Fund is created and hereinafter referred to as the Fund.

25 (c) The Sheriff of Russell County, except for
26 warrants for arrest, may contract with or enter into an

1 agreement with a private, public, or governmental entity for
2 the purpose of service of process.

3 (d) (1) In addition to all existing charges, fees,
4 judgments, and costs of court, the clerk, sheriff, or other
5 appropriate court official in the civil division of the
6 district and circuit courts of Russell County shall assess a
7 service of process fee of fifteen dollars (\$15) per document,
8 and the fees shall be distributed according to this
9 subsection.

10 (2) The court official designated in Russell County
11 by law for the respective courts shall collect the service of
12 process fee designated in this subsection and shall remit
13 two-thirds of the fees collected to the sheriff for deposit
14 into the Fund and one-third of the fees collected to the
15 circuit clerk fund.

16 (e) The sheriff may use the monies generated by this
17 section for law enforcement purposes in the county, at the
18 discretion of the sheriff, including contracting with or
19 entering into a contract or agreement with a private, public,
20 or governmental entity for service of process of documents
21 from the civil division of the district or circuit court. The
22 funds may not revert to the general fund of the county at the
23 end of the fiscal year.

24 (f) The establishment of the Russell County Sheriff
25 Service of Process Fund and the use of the proceeds may not
26 diminish or take the place of any other source of income
27 established for the sheriff or the operation of the jail.

1 (g) The district attorney, law enforcement, and
2 grand juries shall be exempt from payment of the fees provided
3 by this act.

4 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
5 first day of the third month following its passage and
6 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
