26	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Before beginning construction on a structure, a residential home builder licensed under Chapter 14A of Title 34, Code of Alabama 1975, shall provide proof to the homeowner of both current licensure by the Home Builders Licensure Board and liability insurance. The requirements of this section may be waived by agreement of the homeowner and the licensee pursuant to a written waiver, signed by the licensee and the homeowner, and attested by one witness selected by the homeowner. Failure of a residential home builder to comply with this section is a violation of Chapter 14A of Title 34, Code of Alabama 1975, and punishable by the board pursuant to Section 34-14A-14, Code of Alabama 1975.

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the

first day of the third month following its passage and

approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
