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8 SYNOPSIS: This bill would provide a one-time, lump-sum  
9 bonus in the amount of \$1,000 for certain state  
10 employees in the fiscal year beginning October 1,  
11 2017.

17 To provide for a one-time, lump-sum bonus in the  
18 amount of \$1,000 for certain state employees in the fiscal  
19 year beginning October 1, 2017.

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

21 Section 1. Except for the state or local employees  
22 excluded by Section 2, for the 2017-2018 fiscal year only, all  
23 state employees who are listed in the classified and  
24 unclassified service of the state as defined in Section  
25 36-26-10, Code of Alabama 1975, all other state employees and  
26 hourly employees of the state, all legislative personnel,  
27 officers, and employees, including, but not limited to,

1 Legislative Reference Service personnel, whether subject to  
2 the state Merit System or not, and all employees of the county  
3 health departments who are employed subject to the state Merit  
4 System and whose compensation is paid out of a budget provided  
5 and agreed upon by the state, county, or other contributing  
6 agency under the direction of the State Board of Health shall  
7 receive a bonus of one thousand dollars (\$1,000) in a lump-sum  
8 on December 1, 2017.

9 Section 2. (a) The one-time, lump-sum bonus granted  
10 by this act shall in no way apply to any local supplement  
11 provided to any judges or to any other local employee whose  
12 salary is tied to that of any state employee or to any  
13 appellate judge.

14 (b) This act shall not apply to any Merit System  
15 employee or hourly employee whose service or rate of pay is  
16 covered by any labor agreement or contract.

17 Section 3. It is not the intent of this act to make  
18 appropriations, but the appropriations required by this act  
19 shall be made in the annual budget act for the affected  
20 entities.

21 Section 4. The one-time, lump-sum bonus granted in  
22 this act is for fiscal year 2017-2018 only. Nothing in this  
23 act shall authorize this bonus increase in subsequent years.

24 Section 5. This act shall become effective  
25 immediately following its passage and approval by the  
26 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
