15 compensation of an incumbent office holder, the increase shall
16 be paid as provided in subdivision (5) of Section 11-2A-2. The
17 base compensation for the purposes of implementation of this
18 subsection shall be that compensation established on October
19 1, 2000, and shall remain those respective amounts until
20 increased as provided under the provisions of this chapter.

21 "(b) Any provision of this chapter to the contrary
22 notwithstanding, the Legislature, by local law, may increase
23 the compensation for local officials covered under this
24 chapter. However, if a local law increases the compensation of
25 a local official, such local official shall not be entitled to
26 any ~~cost-of-living adjustments~~ uniform increases pursuant to
27 the procedure in subsection (a), until such time as the total

1 compensation he or she would have received under subsection
2 (a) is equal to or exceeds the increase provided by the local
3 law."

4 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
5 first day of the third month following its passage and
6 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
