24	Section 1. Section 15-5-8 of the Code of Alabama
25	1975, is amended to read as follows:
26	" §15-5-8.

"In cases in which the property is to be seized does not include a controlled substance, a search warrant must be executed in the daytime unless the affidavits state positively that the property is on the person or in the place to be searched, in which case it may be executed at any time of the day or night. Except in cases in which the property to be seized includes a controlled substance, the issuing judge or magistrate must state in the warrant, according to the character of the affidavits, whether it is to be executed by day or at any time of the day or night. In cases in which the property to be seized includes a controlled substance, a warrant may be executed at any time of the day or night."

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and

approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
