1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

2 Section 1. On and after the effective date of this 3 act, an agency of the Executive Department of the state that 4 receives appropriations from the General Fund or the Education 5 Trust Fund may not enter into or renew a contract with a 6 lobbyist for lobbying as those terms are defined in Section 7 36-25-1, Code of Alabama 1975.

8 Section 2. This act shall become effective 9 immediately following its passage and approval by the 10 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.

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
