BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, is proposed and shall become valid as a part thereof when approved by a majority of the qualified electors voting thereon and in accordance with Sections 284, 285, and 287 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended:

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

- 1. Any provision of the constitution or other law that imposes a maximum age restriction for the appointment, election, or service of an appointed or elected official is repealed.
- 2. The Legislature may not enact any law imposing a maximum age restriction for the appointment, election, or service of any appointed or elected official.

Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment shall be held in accordance with Sections 284 and 285 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Sections 284 and 285 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this state.

Section 3. The appropriate election official shall 1 2 assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the 3 following description of the substance or subject matter of 4 5 the proposed constitutional amendment: "Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of 6 7 Alabama of 1901, to repeal any existing age restriction on the 8 appointment, election, or service of an appointed or elected 9 official and to prohibit the Legislature from enacting any law 10 imposing a maximum age limitation on the appointment, election, or service of any appointed or elected official. 11 "Proposed by Act ." 12 13 This description shall be followed by the following 14 language: 15 "Yes () No ()."
