27	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALARAMA.

Section 1. In addition to all other appropriations heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated \$1,600,000 from the Education Trust Fund to the Department of Labor for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2016. This appropriation shall be expended for a statewide longitudinal database to enable the state to efficiently and accurately manage, analyze and use education data to improve student learning and outcomes.

Section 2. In addition to all other appropriations heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated \$77,000 from the Education Trust Fund to the Department of Archives and History for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2016. This appropriation shall be expended for professional development and curriculum development for K-12 teachers.

Section 3. This act shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or upon its otherwise becoming law.
