Section 1. Section 9-11-73 is added to the Code of

6 (1) INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION. An institution 7 of higher education located in this state which meets the 8 requirements of and conforms to the definitions contained in 9 the federal Higher Education Act of 1965, as amended, 20 10 United States Code, Section 1001(a) and the regulations, 11 guidelines, and procedures promulgated by the U.S. Secretary 12 of Education.

13 (2) NONRESIDENT STUDENT. A nonresident who is 17
14 years of age or older and under 24 years of age who is
15 enrolled as a full-time student at an institution of higher
16 education.

17 (b) A nonresident student who is enrolled at an 18 institution of higher education may purchase any noncommercial 19 resident hunting, fishing, or combination hunting and fishing 20 license or permit issued pursuant to Chapters 11 and 12, except a lifetime resident hunting or fishing license or a 21 22 combination lifetime resident hunting and fishing license, for 23 the same fee as the respective resident license and shall have 24 the same privileges as a resident holder of the same 25 respective license or permit.

(c) In order to obtain a hunting, fishing, or
 combination hunting and fishing license or permit, a

nonresident student shall submit proof that he or she is a
 nonresident student pursuant to rules adopted by the
 Commissioner of the Department of Conservation and Natural
 Resources.

5 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the 6 first day of the third month following its passage and 7 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
