Section 1. (a) As used in this section, early voting center means a location where registered voters may vote during a period of four to six days immediately preceding election day.

16 (b) The governing body of each county shall 17 designate and provide at least one early voting center. If a 18 governing body designates more than one, it shall have the 19 sole authority to configure boundaries for each early voting 20 center in the county. The governing body, in its discretion, 21 shall determine the days an early voting center will be open 22 for early voting; provided, however, an early voting center 23 must be open not less than four days nor more than six days 24 during the one-week period immediately preceding election day. 25 Hours of operation for each early voting center shall be as follows: 26

(1) On weekdays and Saturdays, early voting centers
 shall be open 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

3 (2) On Sundays, early voting centers shall be open
4 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.

5 (c) Any registered voter may vote in the appropriate
6 early voting center located in his or her county.

7 (d) Nothing in this section shall impair or affect
8 the powers and duties of boards of registrars, judges of
9 probate, and other election officials under Title 17, Code of
10 Alabama 1975, nor shall it affect the procedures and
11 requirements for election day voting.

(e) The Secretary of State shall adopt rules
pursuant to the Administrative Procedure Act required to
implement this section.

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
