The Commissioner of the Department of 5 Corrections, in coordination with the Secretary of the Alabama 6 State Law Enforcement Agency, shall have the authority to 7 promulgate rules to establish a program by January 1 of the 8 year following the effective date of this act to issue a 9 nondriver identification card to a resident parolee upon his 10 or her release from prison.

11 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the 12 first day of the third month following its passage and 13 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
