4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. (a) As used in this section, "leadership position" means any of the following positions: President Pro Tempore of the Senate, Senate Majority Leader, Senate Minority Leader, chair of any Senate standing committee, Speaker of the House of Representatives, Speaker Pro Tempore, House Majority Leader, House Minority Leader, or chair of any House standing committee.

- (b) A member of the Legislature who holds a leadership position and who is indicted in a state court or a federal court for a crime that is a felony, shall be immediately suspended from his or her leadership position. A member suspended under this act shall continue to serve as a legislator. The suspension shall remain in effect until the member is acquitted or the charges are dismissed.
- (c) A vacancy in a leadership position resulting from a suspension under this section shall be filled in accordance with applicable legislative procedure.

Section 2. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
