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8 SYNOPSIS: This bill would provide for the issuance of
9 a distinctive Alabama Literacy Alliance license
10 plate.

11 This bill would provide for an annual
12 additional fee of fifty dollars to be collected for
13 each distinctive license plate issued, for the
14 distribution of the net proceeds to the Alabama
15 Literacy Alliance to defray the operating costs of
16 the alliance, and for the design of the distinctive
17 license plate.

23 Relating to motor vehicles, to provide for the
24 issuance of a distinctive Alabama Literacy Alliance license
25 plate; to provide for an additional annual fee; to provide for
26 the distribution of the net proceeds; and to provide for the
27 design.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

2 Section 1. (a) Notwithstanding the provisions of
3 Section 32-6-64, Code of Alabama 1975, upon application to the
4 judge of probate or license commissioner, compliance with
5 motor vehicle registration and licensing laws, payment of
6 regular fees required by law for license plates for private
7 passenger or pleasure motor vehicles, and payment of an
8 additional annual fee of fifty dollars (\$50), owners of motor
9 vehicles who are residents of Alabama shall be issued
10 distinctive Alabama Literacy Alliance license plates.

11 (b) These plates shall be valid for five years, and
12 may then be replaced with either conventional, personalized,
13 or new Alabama Literacy Alliance plates.

14 (c) Payment of required license fees and taxes for
15 the years during which a new plate is not issued shall be
16 evidenced as provided in Section 32-6-63, Code of Alabama
17 1975.

18 (d) The Board of Directors of the Alabama Literacy
19 Alliance shall design, or have designed, the plate, which
20 design shall be approved by the Commissioner of Revenue.
21 Section 32-6-54, Code of Alabama 1975, shall not apply to the
22 plates designed pursuant to this section.

23 (e) The plates shall be issued, printed, and
24 processed like other distinctive and personalized plates
25 provided for in Chapter 6 of Title 32.

26 (f) The annual additional fee for the motor vehicle
27 license plates shall be distributed in accordance with Section

1 32-6-68 of the Code of Alabama 1975. The Alabama Literacy
2 Alliance, a nonprofit organization, shall receive the portion
3 of the fee as the sponsoring organization, which funds shall
4 be used to defray the costs of operating the alliance.

5 (g) The Department of Revenue may promulgate rules
6 to implement this act.

7 Section 2. All laws or parts of laws which conflict
8 with this act are repealed.

9 Section 3. This act shall become effective on
10 January 1, 2017, following its passage and approval by the
11 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
