8 SYNOPSIS: This bill would propose a local amendment to  
9 the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, relating to  
10 Calhoun County, to provide that any territory  
11 located in the county would be subject only to the  
12 police jurisdiction and planning jurisdiction of a  
13 municipality located wholly or partially in the  
14 county.

16 A BILL  
17 TO BE ENTITLED  
18 AN ACT

20 To propose an amendment to Constitution of Alabama  
21 of 1901, to provide that any territory located in the county  
22 would be subject only to the police jurisdiction and planning  
23 jurisdiction of a municipality located wholly or partially in  
24 the county.

25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

26 Section 1. The following amendment to the  
27 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, is proposed and shall become

1 valid as a part of the Constitution when all requirements of  
2 this act are fulfilled:

3 PROPOSED AMENDMENT

4 (a) This amendment shall apply only in Calhoun  
5 County.

6 (b) Any territory located in Calhoun County shall be  
7 subject only to the police jurisdiction and planning  
8 jurisdiction of a municipality located wholly or partially in  
9 Calhoun County.

10 Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment  
11 shall be held in accordance with Amendment 555 to the  
12 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section  
13 284.01 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of  
14 Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this  
15 state.

16 Section 3. The appropriate election official shall  
17 assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional  
18 amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the  
19 following description of the substance or subject matter of  
20 the proposed constitutional amendment:

21 "Relating to Calhoun County, proposing an amendment  
22 to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, to provide that any  
23 territory located in the county would be subject only to the  
24 police jurisdiction and planning jurisdiction of a  
25 municipality located wholly or partially in the county.

1                    This description shall be followed by the following  
2        language:  
3                    "Yes ( ) No ( )."
