 pursuant to state and federal law and the person has been
 registered to vote in the county at least one year immediately
 prior to qualifying.

5 (4) The person has been awarded a four-year college 6 degree in criminal justice or a related field of study from an 7 accredited university.

8 (5) The person is 25 years of age or older prior to 9 qualifying.

(7) The person has never been convicted of a felony.

(b) Upon election, the sheriff of the county shall
attend annually a minimum of 12 hours of continuing education
approved by the Alabama Sheriff's Association.
