PROPOSED AMENDMENT

4 A city located entirely within the boundaries of Shelby County may not establish a city board of education 5 without first obtaining the approval of a majority of the 6 electors who reside within the corporate limits of the city 7 voting at a referendum. 8

Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment 9 10 shall be held in accordance with Amendment 555 to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section 11 12 284.01 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this 13 state. 14

15 Section 3. The appropriate election official shall 16 assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the 17 18 following description of the substance or subject matter of 19 the proposed constitutional amendment:

20 "Relating to Shelby County, proposing an amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, to prohibit any city 21 22 located entirely within the county from establishing a city 23 board of education without prior approval of the residents of 24 the city voting at a referendum.

"Proposed by Act \_\_\_\_\_" 26 This description shall be followed by the following 27 language:

"Yes ( ) No ( )."
