Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, is proposed and shall become valid as a part of the Constitution when all requirements of this act are fulfilled:

## PROPOSED AMENDMENT

No person elected or appointed sheriff, or any elected or appointed Fayette County official may assume a supernumerary office after the effective date of this amendment. Any person who, on the effective date of this amendment, is entitled to participate in a supernumerary program may continue to participate in that supernumerary program, which shall include the assumption of a supernumerary office according to the terms and conditions of the law which established that supernumerary program. Every elected or appointed Fayette County official may participate in the Employees' Retirement System of Alabama upon the same terms and conditions as may be specified by law for any other employee in the same retirement system. Fayette County officials holding office at the time of the ratification of this amendment shall be eligible to purchase service credit in the Employees' Retirement System for the time the official has served in the current office. For the purposes of this amendment, the words "elected or appointed county official" shall include, subject only to express limitation, any person

holding an office that entitles the person to participate in a 1 2 supernumerary program and includes any person appointed to serve the remaining term of an elected or appointed county 3 official, but shall not include a judge, district attorney, 4 5 constable, legislator, school board member, or any official elected from a judicial circuit. 6 7 Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment 8 shall be held in accordance with Amendment 555 to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, and the election laws of this 9 10 state. 11 Section 3. The appropriate election official shall 12 assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the 13 following description of the substance or subject matter of 14 15 the proposed constitutional amendment: 16 "Relating to Fayette County, proposing an amendment 17 to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, to phase out the 18 supernumerary system for certain elected public officials and 19 allow them to participate in the Employees' Retirement System. Proposed by Act " 20 This description shall be followed by the following 21 22 language: 23 "Yes ( ) No ( )."
