8 SYNOPSIS: Under existing law, salaries of department 9 heads and assistant department heads of the 10 Governor's cabinet and exempt employees and 11 executive assistants in the Governor's office are 12 fixed by the Governor in accordance with 13 recommendations by the State Personnel Board of 14 appropriate pay ranges within the state pay plan.

15 This bill would freeze the salary for 16 department heads and assistant department heads of 17 the Governor's cabinet and exempt employees and 18 executive assistants in the Governor's office, with 19 regard to those individuals serving under the 20 current Governor.

This bill would provide that, beginning January 14, 2019, department heads and assistant department heads of the Governor's cabinet and exempt employees and executive assistants in the Governor's office shall be deemed classified employees for purposes of salary increases.

members of the Governor's cabinet, the salaries of the 1 2 appointed assistant department heads or those otherwise considered as the Governor's assistant cabinet members, and 3 the salaries of other officers and employees appointed in the 4 5 exempt service and the executive assistants in the Governor's office shall be fixed by the Governor in accordance with the 6 7 recommendations by the State Personnel Board of appropriate 8 pay ranges within the state pay plan.

9 "(b) <u>Beginning on the effective date of the act</u> 10 <u>adding this sentence and continuing through January 13, 2019,</u> 11 <u>the Governor may not increase the salary of any officer or</u> 12 <u>employee whose salary is subject to increase pursuant to</u> 13 <u>subsection (a).</u>

"(c) Beginning with the Governor's term that begins
January 14, 2019, officers and employees whose salary is
subject to increase pursuant to subsection (a) shall be deemed
classified employees pursuant to Section 36-26-10 for purposes
of salary increases.

19 "(d) Where some authority other than the Governor 20 appoints such an officer or employee, the salary shall be 21 fixed by the appointing authority with the approval of the 22 Governor and the State Personnel Board.

"(c) (e) In fixing such salaries, the Governor or
other appointing authority shall give due consideration to the
salaries of comparable positions in other states and in
private industry in Alabama.

1	"(f) A member of the Governor's cabinet may not
2	serve in an acting capacity for more than 90 days."
3	Section 2. This act shall become effective
4	immediately following its passage and approval by the
5	Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
