26	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. An individual who, for compensation, 1 2 provides policy-related advice to an officer or director of a 3 state agency, may be compensated for his or her services, whether directly or indirectly, only from public funds. For 4 5 purposes of this section, officer or director of a state agency means an officer or employee of an agency, department, 7 office, or other instrumentality of the Executive Department 8 of the state, who has decision-making authority or control 9 over policies affecting that state agency, department, office, 10 or instrumentality. Section 2. This act shall become effective 11 12 immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law. 13
