5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. PAY INCREASES, FY 2016-2017. (a) The 6 7 State Budget Officer shall allocate to the State Board of Education, the Board of Trustees of the Alabama Institute for 8 Deaf and Blind, the Board of Youth Services School District, 9 10 the Board of Directors of the Alabama School of Fine Arts, and the Board of Trustees of the Alabama School of Mathematics and 11 12 Science and for disbursement to the employees thereof funds based on the criteria established in this act. It is not the 13 intent of this act to make appropriations, but the 14 15 appropriations required by this act shall be made in the 16 annual Education Trust Fund budget act for the designated 17 fiscal year.

18 (1) Certificated Personnel (K-12). For the fiscal 19 year beginning October 1, 2016, and each year thereafter, each 20 certificated employee at all city and county school systems 21 and the teachers at the Department of Youth Services School 22 District shall receive a five percent salary increase. Each step and cell on the State Minimum Salary Schedule contained 23 24 in the annual budget act for the public schools shall be in-25 creased by the amounts below for fiscal year 2016-2017, the 26 State Minimum Salary Schedule shall reflect the following percentage increase: 27

All certificated employees, including the Adult 12 Basic Education and Science in Motion employees, shall be 13 14 guaranteed pay increases in the amounts indicated above for 15 their years of experience and degrees earned and the 16 corresponding pay increases shall be reflected in the 17 appropriate local salary schedule and paid to each 18 certificated employee. The provisions and requirements of this 19 act shall be in addition to the provisions of Section 20 16-13-231.1, Code of Alabama 1975, relating to the State 21 Minimum Salary Schedule. Each certificated employee shall be 22 properly placed on the local salary schedule according to 23 degree earned and years of public education service (either

in-state or out-of-state), which shall be not less than the 1 2 amounts appropriated for the State Minimum Salary Schedule. The employee shall be paid according to degree earned and 3 4 length of public education experience. The pay increase shall 5 be given to each person employed for the 2016-2017 fiscal year in addition to any state or local step increase to which the 6 7 employee is otherwise entitled. The local board of education shall transmit to the State Department of Education the 8 appropriate notice of the earned advanced degree for each 9 10 employee in a timely fashion; thereafter, the employee shall 11 be paid for the advanced degree as soon as the degree is 12 certified to the State Department of Education as being 13 earned.

(2) Education Support Personnel (K-12). A five 14 15 percent pay increase, beginning with the fiscal year 16 2016-2017, shall be paid to each public education support worker and adult bus driver, including Adult Basic Education 17 18 and Science in Motion personnel, employed for the 2016-2017 19 fiscal year in addition to the salary received during the 20 2015-2016 fiscal year, except employees covered under the 21 state's Merit System at the Department of Youth Services 22 District. Each governing body or authority shall establish and 23 maintain a salary schedule for each class and type of employee 24 and each step of each salary schedule shall be increased to 25 reflect a five percent pay increase beginning with fiscal year 2016-2017, which shall be given to the person employed 26 27 full-time for the 2016-2017 fiscal year and each year employed

full-time thereafter. The base rate of pay for part-time support employees shall be increased by five percent beginning with fiscal year 2016-2017. A separate local salary schedule shall be established and maintained for each specific job performed.

6 (3) AIDB. For the fiscal year 2016-2017, employees 7 at the Alabama Institute for Deaf and Blind shall receive a 8 pay increase which shall be in excess of their salaries 9 received during the 2015-2016 fiscal year. The increase shall 10 be as follows:

a. Certificated. The salary schedule for certifi cated employees shall be revised to reflect at least the fol lowing percentage increase beginning with the fiscal year
 2016-2017:

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b. Education Support Personnel (K-12). A five percent pay increase, beginning with the 2016-2017 fiscal year, shall be given to each support worker employed full-time by the Alabama Institute for Deaf and Blind. A separate local salary schedule shall be established and maintained for each specific job performed. The pay increase in this act shall be

8 incorporated into the support employees' salary schedules. The 9 base rate of pay for part-time support employees shall be 10 increased by five percent for the 2016-2017 fiscal year.

11 c. Miscellaneous Requirements. The AIDB board shall establish and maintain a salary schedule for each class and 12 13 type of employee and each step of each salary schedule for 14 fiscal year 2016-2017 shall be increased to reflect the pay 15 increase above to be given to each person employed for the 16 2016-2017 fiscal year and each year employed thereafter. The pay increase contained in this subsection shall be paid to 17 18 each employee.

(4) Two-Year Postsecondary Institutions. The Board of Trustees of the Community College System shall revise all salary schedules of the two-year postsecondary institutions to reflect an increase of five percent for the 2016-2017 fiscal year. The pay increase shall be given to each person employed in addition to any step increase to which the employee is otherwise entitled. The Postsecondary Education Department

shall take proper steps to ensure that employees on all salary 1 2 schedules are given full credit for prior work experience in the public schools and colleges, and shall take care to ensure 3 proper placements on the salary schedules. Placement on the 4 5 revised salary schedules shall be in accordance with the employee's length of service in public education. No pay 6 7 increase shall be given to any two-year postsecondary employee in excess of five percent, except as specifically provided in 8 this act. 9

10 (5) Miscellaneous provisions. The following11 provisions are hereby established:

a. Fiscal Year. All salaries and salary increases
which are established by the State Board of Education shall be
paid in full to each person employed before the end of the
applicable fiscal year as defined in Section 16-1-1 of the
Code of Alabama 1975, as amended.

b. Extended Work. Public K-12 school employees on
contracts which extend beyond 187 days, or the hourly
equivalent thereof, shall be given a pro rata salary increment
for each or partial day of work extending beyond 187 days.

21 c. Local Increment. Any cost-of-living adjustment 22 and/or increase on the State Minimum Salary Schedule for 23 teachers as provided in this act shall be exclusive of any 24 local pay increase granted or due to teachers under provisions 25 of any local salary schedule. Any cost-of-living adjustment 26 and/or pay increase required by this act for public school 27 support personnel shall be in addition to any pay increase due

or granted to the employee under provisions of any local 1 2 salary schedules. The pay increase provisions of this act shall not apply to any salary supplements granted by local 3 boards of education, bonuses earned for certification by the 4 5 National Board of Professional Teaching Standards, or the federal portion of the salary paid to a Junior Reserve Officer 6 7 Training Corps (JROTC) instructor employed by a local school 8 board.

9 d. Community Education. Each county and city board 10 of education shall have the option to exclude from the 11 provisions of this act any part-time employees of community 12 education or school-sponsored child care or child enrichment 13 program which is supplemental to the state-required 14 educational program.

e. Local Chief Executive Officers. The pay increase provisions of this act shall not apply to superintendents of education of any school system or institution. Any pay increase given to the superintendent shall be by majority recorded vote of the governing body or authority.

20 Section 2. The pay increase granted in this act 21 shall begin in fiscal year 2016-2017 and continue in 22 subsequent years. Nothing in this act shall authorize 23 additional pay increases in subsequent years.

24 Section 3. The provisions of this act are severable. 25 If any part of this act is declared invalid or 26 unconstitutional, that declaration shall not affect the part 27 which remains.

Section 4. This act shall become effective
 immediately following its passage and approval by the
 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
