8 SYNOPSIS: This bill would propose a constitutional
9 amendment to prohibit the expenditures of any funds
10 appropriated to the Forever Wild Land Trust for
11 advertising, promotion, or marketing of the Forever
12 Wild Land Trust or any services or benefits
13 provided by the trust.

19 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of
20 Alabama of 1901, as amended, relating to the Forever Wild Land
21 Trust; to prohibit the expenditures of any funds appropriated
22 to the Forever Wild Land Trust for advertising, promotion, or
23 marketing of the Forever Wild Land Trust or any services or
24 benefits provided by the trust.

25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

26 Section 1. The following amendment to the
27 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, is proposed and

1 shall become valid as a part thereof when approved by a
2 majority of the qualified electors voting thereon and in
3 accordance with Sections 284, 285, and 287 of the Constitution
4 of Alabama of 1901, as amended:

5 PROPOSED AMENDMENT

6 Funds appropriated to the Forever Wild Land Trust
7 may not be used for advertising, promotion, or marketing of
8 the Forever Wild Land Trust or any services or benefits
9 provided by the trust.

10 Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment
11 shall be held in accordance with Sections 284 and 285 of the
12 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Sections 284
13 and 285 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of
14 Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this
15 state.

16 Section 3. The appropriate election official shall
17 assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional
18 amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the
19 following description of the substance or subject matter of
20 the proposed constitutional amendment:

21 "Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of
22 Alabama of 1901, as amended, relating to the Forever Wild Land
23 Trust; to prohibit the expenditures of any funds appropriated
24 to the Forever Wild Land Trust for advertising, promotion, or
25 marketing of the Forever Wild Land Trust or any services or
26 benefits provided by the trust.
