valid as a part of the Constitution when all requirements of this act are fulfilled:

## PROPOSED AMENDMENT

- (a) The Judge of Probate of Baldwin County shall be an attorney licensed in this state effective upon the election or appointment of any judge of probate after the ratification of the amendment.
- exercise equity jurisdiction concurrent with that of the circuit court in cases originally filed in the Probate Court of Baldwin County. In any case subject to this amendment, the judge of probate shall possess the power and authority of a circuit court judge trying the case and the case shall be treated in all respects in the same manner as a case filed in circuit court. The Alabama Rules of Civil Procedure shall apply in the cases except as otherwise specifically provided by law. This amendment is self-executing, but the Legislature may enact additional laws to implement this amendment if needed.

Section 2. The appropriate election official shall assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the following description of the substance or subject matter of the proposed constitutional amendment:

"Relating to Baldwin County, proposing an amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, to require the Judge of Probate of Baldwin County to be an attorney and to
