25	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
26	Section 1. (a) The State Board of Education shall
27	develop all of the following:

1 (1) A model evaluation system for use in evaluating 2 the effectiveness of teachers providing classroom instruction 3 and teachers serving as principals or assistant principals in 4 public K-12 schools.

5 (2) A model tenure system for use in granting and 6 denying tenure to teachers, and teachers serving as assistant 7 principals and principals, based on fair and impartial 8 considerations and due process.

9 (b) On or before the fifth legislative day of the 10 2017 Regular Session, the board shall submit a detailed 11 summary of both the model evaluation system and the model 12 tenure system to the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, the 13 Speaker of the House of Representatives, and the Chairs of the 14 House Education Policy Committee and the Senate Education and 15 Youth Affairs Committee.

16 Section 2. This act shall become effective 17 immediately following its passage and approval by the 18 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
