his or her place, who shall assume all duties of the elected
 official relating to the entity, including all voting rights.

3 (b) A state elected official may designate only a
4 state employee, a county elected official may designate only a
5 county employee, and a municipal employee may designate only a
6 municipal employee.

7 (c) A designee under subsection (a) shall serve at
8 the pleasure of the elected official and for the duration of
9 the elected official's term of office.

(d) This section applies to a general or local law
enacted prior to, on, or after the effective date of this act.

12 Section 2. This act shall become effective 13 immediately following its passage and approval by the 14 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
