23	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
24	Section 1. Section 36-21-51, Code of Alabama 1975,
25	is amended to read as follows:
26	"§36-21-51.

"(a)(1) Each chief of police of any municipality in 1 this state shall annually complete 20 hours of executive level 2 continuing education courses training as approved by the 3 commission. 4 5 "(2) In addition to the requirements in subdivision (1), a chief of police of a governmental or quasi-governmental 6 7 law enforcement agency or the chief of police of a municipality with a population of less than 100,000 8 inhabitants according to the most recent federal decennial 9 10 census, within one year of appointment, shall complete an 11 approved law enforcement executive management course, adopted 12 by the Alabama Association of Chiefs of Police and approved by the commission. 13

"(b) Any other law enforcement officer in this state 14 15 shall annually complete 12 hours of continuing education courses approved by the commission. Provided, however, in the 16 17 case of a law enforcement officer employed by a county 18 sheriff's department, the training shall be required only if 19 the county commission of the county in which the officer 20 serves shall adopt a resolution requiring such continuing 21 education.

"(b)(c) Any chief of police or law enforcement
officer who fails or refuses to comply with this section shall
be subject to having his or her certification or authority as
a law enforcement officer revoked by the commission.

26 "(c)(d) The commission may, for sufficient cause,
 27 grant an extension of time in which to complete the courses.

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"(d) (e) Any chief of police or law enforcement
officer who is aggrieved by any order or ruling made under
this section shall have the same rights and procedure of
appeal as from any other order or ruling of the commission."
Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
first day of the third month following its passage and
approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
