1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Section 11 of Act 2016-199, 2016 Regular
Session, is amended to read as follows:

"Section 11. The State Superintendent of Education 4 may approve a request by a local board of education for 5 redirecting Other Current Expense funds designated for 6 7 pass-through calculations to their local Child Nutrition 8 Program if the redirected funds do not prevent the Child 9 Nutrition Program of that local board of education from 10 maintaining a positive fund balance equal to or greater than a two-month operating reserve." 11

Section 2. This act shall become effective October 1, 2016, following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
