20	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
21	Section 1. The following amendment to the
22	Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, is proposed and
23	shall become valid as a part thereof when approved by a
24	majority of the qualified electors voting thereon and in
25	accordance with Sections 284, 285, and 287 of the Constitution
26	of Alabama of 1901, as amended:
27	PROPOSED AMENDMENT

Section 1. (a) The Governor or the Governor's designee is hereby authorized and instructed to negotiate in good faith and conclude a compact for the operation of Class III gaming as defined in the Indian Gaming Regulatory Act, and which includes, but is not limited to: (1) slot machines, (2) video lottery terminals, (3) banking or banked card games, including, but not limited to, baccarat, chemin de fer, and blackjack, and (4) table games, including, but not limited to, roulette and craps, with the Poarch Band of Creek Indians on lands held in trust by the United States for the benefit of the Poarch Band of Creek Indians pursuant to Section 5 of the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934.

- (b) Gaming pursuant to a compact as described in this section is permitted to be conducted and operated by the Poarch Band of Creek Indians for a term of more than 25 years on those lands held in trust by the United States for the benefit of the Poarch Band of Creek Indians pursuant to Section 5 of the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934 in return for consideration under terms to be established in the compact.
- (c) Notwithstanding Section 22 of Article I or Section 93 of Article IV of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, the Governor, or the Governor's designee, in addition to any and all other powers of the office which may exist now or hereafter, may negotiate, execute, and deliver any and all documents on behalf of the state, and enter into any agreement or compact,

or both, on behalf of the state, with any potential gaming operator in furtherance of any gaming and resort project if the gaming and resort project is likely to provide or maintain job opportunities to individuals, including citizens and residents of the state, even if the project is to be located on property owned by or held in trust by the United States for the benefit of the Poarch Band of Creek Indians. In furtherance of the powers set forth herein, and in addition to any and all other powers which may exist now or hereafter, the state may provide, without limitation as to any other rights or interests which it is authorized to provide under relevant law, contractual, license, or licensure rights to any one or more parties, without regard to any type of request for proposal process and without regard to whether the contractual or licensure rights are granted on an exclusive or non-exclusive basis or whether in perpetuity or shorter period of time, so long as the provision or granting of rights or interest or other thing of value by the state to any potential gaming operator has been negotiated in good faith. If negotiated in good faith by the state, any consideration received or to be received by the state pursuant to this amendment, whether monetary or otherwise, shall be adequate and no action shall be had for private inurement or other unlawful waste, use, or misappropriation of public funds.

(d) Following completion of negotiations and execution of a compact, the Governor or the Governor's designee shall submit a copy of the executed compact to the

President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives as soon as it is executed. The Governor or the Governor's designee shall file the executed compact with the Secretary of State.

- (e) The Secretary of State shall forward a copy of any executed compact to the United States Secretary of the Interior for his or her review and approval, in accordance with 25 U.S.C. § 2710(d)(8).
- of Creek Indians relating to or arising from the compact or compact negotiations may be resolved in the courts of the United States, which shall have jurisdiction over the state. The state's immunity under the Eleventh Amendment of the United States Constitution is expressly waived for the limited purpose of dispute resolution in federal court, contingent upon an equivalent submission by the Poarch Band of Creek Indians to the jurisdiction of the federal court.

Section 2. The operation of this amendment is not subject to, prohibited, limited, or impaired by any other constitutional provision or statute, whenever enacted, that is inconsistent with the provisions of this amendment.

Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment shall be held in accordance with Sections 284 and 285 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Sections 284 and 285 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this state.

1	Section 3. The appropriate election official shall
2	assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional
3	amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the
4	following description of the substance or subject matter of
5	the proposed constitutional amendment:
6	"Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of
7	Alabama of 1901, to require the Governor to negotiate a gaming
8	compact with the Poarch Band of Creek Indians.
9	"Proposed by Act"
10	This description shall be followed by the following
11	language:
12	"Yes () No ()."
