3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, is proposed and shall become valid as a part thereof when approved by a majority of the qualified electors voting thereon and in accordance with Sections 284, 285, and 287 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended:

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

- (a) After December 31, 2016, an additional state ad valorem tax shall be levied at the rate of four (4) mill per annum on the assessed value of the taxable property within the state subject to exemptions, valuations, and limitations provided for by general law.
- (b) The net proceeds of three (3) mills per annum on the assessed value of taxable property of the tax levied by subsection (a) shall be distributed to the State General Fund for Medicaid purposes.
- (c) The net proceeds of one (1) mill per annum on the assessed value of taxable property of the tax levied by subsection (a) shall be distributed to the Metropolitan Planning Organizations within the State of Alabama to be used for public transit.

Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment shall be held in accordance with Sections 284 and 285 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Sections 284

and 285 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of
Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this
state at the next statewide primary, general or special
election held for that purpose.

Section 3. The appropriate election official shall
assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional

assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the following description of the substance or subject matter of the proposed constitutional amendment:

"Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, to provide an additional four (4) mill of ad valorem tax on taxable property in the state, to take effect after December 31, 2016, and distributing the net proceeds of three (3) mills of ad valorem tax to the State General Fund for Medicaid purposes and the net proceeds of one (1) mill of ad valorem tax to the Metropolitan Planning Organizations within the State of Alabama for public transit.
