3 To amend Section 13A-7-22, Code of Alabama 1975, relating to the crime of criminal mischief in the second 4 5 degree; to provide enhanced penalties for a second or subsequent conviction involving a church or other religious 6 7 building, or property in the church or other religious 8 building; to provide for restitution to the church or other religious entity to be a priority under certain conditions; 9 10 and in connection therewith would have as its purpose or 11 effect the requirement of a new or increased expenditure of 12 local funds within the meaning of Amendment 621 of the 13 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section 14 111.05 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended. 15

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Section 13A-7-22, Code of Alabama 1975,
is amended to read as follows:

"§13A-7-22.

"(a) A person commits the crime of criminal mischief in the second degree if, with intent to damage property, and having no right to do so or any reasonable ground to believe that he or she has such a right, he or she inflicts damages to property in an amount which exceeds five hundred dollars HB28

1	(\$500) but does not exceed two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500).			
2	"(b) <u>(1)</u> Criminal mischief in the second degree is a			
3	Class A misdemeanor punishable as provided by law.			
4	"(2) Upon a second conviction of criminal mischief			
5	in the second degree within a five-year period involving			
6	damage to a church or other religious building, or damage to			
7	property in a church or other religious building, the			
8	defendant shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum sentence			
9	of not less than 10 days in jail and upon a third or			
10	subsequent conviction of criminal mischief in the second			
11	degree within a five-year period involving damage to a church			
12	or other religious building, or damage to property in a church			
13	or other religious building, the defendant shall be sentenced			
14	to a mandatory minimum sentence of not less than 30 days in			
15	jail.			
16	"(3) Upon conviction for criminal mischief in the			
17	second degree involving a church or other religious building			
18	or damage to property in a church or other religious building,			
19	the court shall order restitution as a first priority before			
20	the payment of fines, court costs, or other court ordered			
21	payments.			
22	Section 2. Although this bill would have as its			
23	purpose or effect the requirement of a new or increased			
24	expenditure of local funds, the bill is excluded from further			
25	requirements and application under Amendment 621, now			

appearing as Section 111.05 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, because the bill defines a new crime or amends the definition of an existing crime.

5 Section 3. All laws or parts of laws which conflict 6 with this act are repealed.

Section 4. This act shall become effective on the
first day of the third month following its passage and
approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
