8 SYNOPSIS: This bill would require funeral homes, upon
9 entering into funeral service agreements, to submit
10 the Social Security numbers of the deceased persons
11 to the Internal Revenue Service.

17 Relating to funeral services; to add Section
18 34-13-13 to the Code of Alabama 1975, to require funeral
19 establishments to submit the Social Security numbers of the
20 deceased persons to the Internal Revenue Service upon entering
21 into an agreement to provide funeral services.

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

23 Section 1. Section 34-13-13 is added to the Code of
24 Alabama 1975, to read as follows:

25 §34-13-13.

26 (a) Upon entering into a funeral service agreement,
27 a funeral establishment shall submit to the Internal Revenue

1 Service the Social Security number of the deceased person on a
2 form prescribed by the board.

3 (b) The board may adopt rules to carry out the
4 provisions of this section.

5 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
6 first day of the third month following its passage and
7 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
