1 plates in this state may be issued military motorcycle license
2 plates in the license plate category for which they qualify to
3 receive military license plates. Provided, where a
4 registration fee or ad valorem tax exemption or deduction is
5 available for private passenger automobile, pickup truck and
6 pleasure motor vehicle license plates in a military license
7 plate category, the same exemption or deduction will apply to
8 the motorcycle license plates in the same military license
9 plate category.

10 (b) Payment of required license fees and taxes for
11 the years during which a new tag or plate is not issued shall
12 be evidenced as provided in Section 32-6-63.

13 (c) The design for the military motorcycle plates
14 shall be the same design as plates for private passenger
15 automobiles, pickup trucks and pleasure motor vehicles in each
16 military license plate category.

17 (d) The Department of Revenue may promulgate rules
18 to implement this section.

19 Section 2. This act shall become effective on
20 January 1, 2016, following its passage and approval by the
21 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
