ENROLLED, An Act,

Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, to allow the Judge of Probate of Houston County to exercise equity jurisdiction concurrent with that of the circuit court in cases originally filed in the Probate Court of Houston County if the judge of probate is licensed to practice law in the State of Alabama.

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

10 Section 1. The following amendment to the 11 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, is proposed and shall become 12 valid as a part of the Constitution when all requirements of 13 this act are fulfilled:

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

15 The Judge of Probate of Houston County may exercise 16 equity jurisdiction concurrent with that of the circuit court 17 in cases originally filed in the Probate Court of Houston 18 County if the judge of probate is licensed to practice law in 19 the State of Alabama. In any case subject to this amendment, the judge of probate shall possess the power and authority of 20 21 a circuit court judge trying the case and the case shall be 22 treated in all respects in the same manner as a case filed in 23 circuit court. The Alabama Rules of Civil Procedure shall 24 apply in the cases except as otherwise specifically provided 25 by law. This amendment is self-executing, but the Legislature 1 may enact additional laws to implement this amendment if 2 needed.

3 Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment 4 shall be held in accordance with Amendment 555 to the 5 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, and the election laws of this 6 state.

Section 3. The appropriate election official shall assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the following description of the substance or subject matter of the proposed constitutional amendment:

"Relating to Houston County, proposing an amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, to allow the Judge of Probate of Houston County to exercise equity jurisdiction concurrent with that of the circuit court in cases originally filed in the Probate Court of Houston County if the Judge of Probate is licensed to practice law in the State of Alabama.
