Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law, if, and only if, an amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, is ratified which authorizes the Governor to appoint a person to fill a vacancy in the office of senator or representative in the Legislature pursuant to this act.
