- "(a) The commissioner shall collect the following fees in the administration and enforcement of this chapter:

- "(2) Late filing fee, to be paid by each producer and service representative failing to make a timely filing of the compliance form renew a license...... \$50.
- "(3) Provider authority initial filing fee, a one-time fee to be paid by each education course provider for

- "(4) Provider authority annual renewal fee, to be paid by each education course provider for continuation of authority to offer continuing education courses in this state...... \$100.

 - "(b) The fees collected pursuant to this section shall be deposited in the State Treasury to the credit of the Insurance Department Fund."

Section 2. There is appropriated from the Insurance Department Fund in the State Treasury to the Department of Insurance the sum of five million dollars (\$5,000,000) for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2016. Of this amount, For the fiscal years ending September 30, 2016, September 30, 2017, and September 30, 2018, up to two million five hundred thousand dollars (\$2,500,000) may be transferred from the Insurance Department Fund by the Commissioner of Insurance to the Strengthen Alabama Homes Fund established pursuant to Section 27-31E-2, Code of Alabama 1975. The appropriation made in this section is in addition to any and all other funds

heretofore or hereafter appropriated to the Department of
Insurance.

Section 3. There is appropriated from the Strengthen Alabama Homes Fund in the State Treasury established pursuant to Section 27-31E-2, Code of Alabama 1975, to the Department of Insurance the sum of two million five hundred thousand dollars (\$2,500,000) for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2016. The appropriation made in this section is in addition to any and all other funds heretofore or hereafter appropriated to the Department of Insurance.

Section 4. This act shall be effective January 1, 2016.
