8 SYNOPSIS: This bill would propose an amendment to the
9 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, to provide that a
10 cost of living increase for state employees could
11 not become law unless the provision would also
12 apply to public education employees and retired
13 state and public education employees.

19 To propose an amendment to the Constitution of
20 Alabama of 1901, to provide that a cost of living increase for
21 state employees may not become law unless the increase also
22 applies to public education employees and retired state and
23 public education employees.

24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

25 Section 1. The following amendment to the
26 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, is proposed and
27 shall become valid as a part thereof when approved by a

1 majority of the qualified electors voting thereon and in
2 accordance with Sections 284, 285, and 287 of the Constitution
3 of Alabama of 1901, as amended:

4 PROPOSED AMENDMENT

5 A cost of living increase for state employees may
6 not become law unless the provision also applies to public
7 education employees and retired state and public education
8 employees.

9 Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment
10 shall be held in accordance with Sections 284 and 285 of the
11 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election
12 laws of this state.

13 Section 3. The appropriate election official shall
14 assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional
15 amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the
16 following description of the substance or subject matter of
17 the proposed constitutional amendment: "Proposing an amendment
18 to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, to provide that a cost
19 of living increase for state employees may not become law
20 unless the provision also applies to public education
21 employees and retired state and public education employees.

22 "Proposed by Act _____."

23 This description shall be followed by the following
24 language:

25 "Yes () No ()."
