22	Section 1. (a) Any policy of automobile insurance,
23	including any automobile liability insurance policy, any
24	policy of insurance covering property damage to the automobile
25	of the insured, or any other coverage provided in conjunction
26	with an automobile insurance policy, shall provide coverage
27	when the insured is driving a covered automobile on a highway,

road, or street that has been closed due to inclement weather if the insured is a public safety employee, such as a policeman or fireman, or other critical needs employee driving to and from work. The coverage provided shall be the same as the coverage provided if the road was not closed.

6 (b) For purposes of this section, the term "critical 7 needs employee" means a person whose job is to provide 8 lifesaving services or to provide support for those providing 9 lifesaving services.

Section 2. This act shall apply to any insurance
policy issued after the effective date of this act.

12 Section 3. This act shall become effective on the 13 first day of the third month following its passage and 14 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
