ENROLLED, An Act,

Relating to the City of Fort Payne in DeKalb County;
authorizing the sale of draft or keg beer or malt beverages by
properly licensed retail licensees of the Alcoholic Beverage
Control Board upon the adoption of an ordinance of the Fort
Payne City Council.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. This act shall only apply to the City of
Fort Payne in DeKalb County.

Section 2. The sale of draft or keg beer or malt
beverages by retail licensees of the Alcoholic Beverage
Control Board is authorized in the City of Fort Payne. All
resolutions and ordinances relating to the sale, consumption,
and possession of bottled or canned beer in such city shall
apply to draft or keg beer or malt beverages. The Fort Payne
City Council may adopt an ordinance regulating the sale of
draft or keg beer or malt beverages pursuant to this act.

Section 3. All laws or parts of laws which conflict
with this act are repealed. However, the provisions of this
act are cumulative and supplementary and shall not be
construed to repeal or supersede any laws or parts of laws not
directly inconsistent herewith.

1 Section 4. This act shall become effective
2 immediately following its passage and approval by the
3 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
