163962-1:n:01/07/2015:KMS/th LRS2015-29 1 2 3 4 5 6 7 SYNOPSIS: Under existing law, the Board of Trustees of 8 the University of Alabama is responsible for the 9 10 management and control of all campuses of the 11 University of Alabama System. 12 This bill would propose an amendment to the 13 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, to create a separate supervisory board of trustees for the 14 15 University of Alabama at Birmingham to provide for 16 the general management and operation of the 17 University of Alabama at Birmingham, subject to the 18 approval of the Board of Trustees of the University 19 of Alabama System in instances affecting the entire 20 system, and to provide for the day-to-day operation 21 of the University of Alabama at Birmingham. 22 23 A BILL 24 TO BE ENTITLED 25 AN ACT

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1 Proposing an amendment to Section 264 of the 2 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended by Amendment 399, now appearing as Section 264 of the Official Recompilation of 3 the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, relating to 4 the Board of Trustees of the University of Alabama; to create 5 a separate supervisory board of trustees for the University of 6 7 Alabama at Birmingham; to provide for the general management and operation of the University of Alabama at Birmingham by 8 9 the supervisory board, subject to the approval of the Board of Trustees of the University of Alabama System in certain 10 instances; and to provide for the day-to-day operation of the 11 12 University of Alabama at Birmingham by the supervisory board. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA: 13

14 Section 1. The following amendment to the 15 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, is proposed and 16 shall become valid as a part thereof when approved by a 17 majority of the qualified electors voting thereon and in 18 accordance with Sections 284, 285, and 287 of the Constitution 19 of Alabama of 1901, as amended:

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"Section 264. Board of trustees of state university.

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

"(a) The state university shall be under the management and control of a board of trustees, which shall consist of two members from each congressional district in the state, an additional member from the congressional district which includes the site of the first campus of the university, the superintendent of education Superintendent of Education,

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and the governor Governor, who shall be ex officio president 1 2 of the board. The members of the board of trustees as now constituted shall hold office until their respective terms 3 4 expire under existing law, and until their successors shall be elected and confirmed as hereinafter required. The additional 5 6 trustees provided for by this amendment shall be elected by 7 the existing members of the board, and confirmed by the senate Senate in the manner provided below, for initial terms of not 8 more than six years established by the board so that one term 9 10 shall expire each three years in each congressional district. Successors to the terms of the existing and additional 11 12 trustees shall hold office for a term of six years, and shall 13 not serve more than three consecutive full six-year terms on 14 the board; provided however that a. A trustee shall retire from the board and vacate office at the annual meeting of the 15 board following that trustee's seventieth birthday. Election 16 17 of additional and successor trustees or of trustees to fill any vacancy created by the expiration of a term or by the 18 death or resignation of any member or from any other cause 19 20 shall be by the remaining members of the board by secret 21 ballot; provided, that any. Any trustee so elected shall hold 22 office from the date of election until confirmation or 23 rejection by the senate Senate, and, if confirmed, until the 24 expiration of the term for which elected, and until a 25 successor is elected. At every meeting of the legislature 26 Legislature the superintendent of education Superintendent of 27 Education shall certify to the senate Senate the names of all

who shall have been so elected since the last session of the 1 2 legislature Legislature, and the senate Senate shall confirm or reject them, as it shall determine is for the best interest 3 4 of the university. If it rejects the names of any members, it shall thereupon elect trustees in the stead of those rejected. 5 6 No trustee shall receive any pay or emolument other than his 7 or her actual expenses incurred in the discharge of his or her duties as such. Upon the vacation of office by a trustee, the 8 board, if it desires, may bestow upon a trustee the honorary 9 10 title of trustee emeritus, but such status shall confer no responsibilities, duties, rights, or privileges as such. 11

12 "(b) The University of Alabama at Birmingham shall 13 be under the management and control of a supervisory board of 14 trustees. The supervisory board may act and make decisions 15 concerning the general management and operation of the University of Alabama at Birmingham and shall be responsible 16 17 for the day-to-day operation of the University of Alabama at Birmingham. The Board of Trustees of the University of Alabama 18 may review and rescind actions of the supervisory board which 19 have a detrimental effect upon the entire university system. 20 The supervisory board shall consist of five members, at least 21 22 three of whom shall be graduates of the University of Alabama 23 at Birmingham. Each member of the supervisory board shall be a 24 resident of Jefferson County for at least one year immediately 25 preceding nomination to the supervisory board and shall reside 26 in the county during the entire term of office. A chair and 27 vice chair of the supervisory board shall be elected from its

1	membership. The members of the supervisory board shall meet
2	with the Board of Trustees of the University of Alabama
3	System, at the times and places as may be mutually agreed
4	upon. Due notice of meetings shall be given by the board of
5	trustees, for the purpose of reporting and giving information
6	and advice to the trustees regarding the proper maintenance
7	and operation of the University of Alabama at Birmingham. The
8	initial members of the supervisory board shall be appointed by
9	the Board of Trustees of the University of Alabama: One for a
10	term of two years, two for a term of three years, and two for
11	a term of four years. Thereafter, all members of the
12	supervisory board shall be elected by the Board of Trustees of
13	the University of Alabama, on nominations made by the
14	remaining members of the supervisory board, for four-year
15	terms. Vacancies on the supervisory board shall be filled in
16	the same manner by the Board of Trustees of the University of
17	Alabama, and the appointees shall serve for the unexpired
18	terms. The members of the supervisory board shall serve
19	without compensation, but shall be reimbursed for their actual
20	expenses incurred in the discharge of their duties, to be paid
21	in the same manner as the expenses of the university trustees
22	are paid. The President of the University of Alabama at
23	Birmingham shall be an ex officio nonvoting member of the
24	supervisory board and may sit with that body during
25	deliberations."
26	Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment

27 shall be held in accordance with Sections 284 and 285 of the

1 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Sections 284 2 and 285 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of 3 Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this 4 state.

5 Section 3. The appropriate election official shall 6 assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional 7 amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the 8 following description of the substance or subject matter of 9 the proposed constitutional amendment:

10 "Proposing an amendment to Section 264, as amended 11 by Amendment 399, of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now 12 appearing as Section 264 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, relating to the 13 14 Board of Trustees of the University of Alabama; to create a 15 supervisory Board of Trustees for the University of Alabama at Birmingham as a separate body under the University of Alabama 16 17 System to provide for the general management and operation of the University of Alabama at Birmingham, subject to the 18 19 approval of the Board of Trustees of the University of Alabama System concerning actions affecting the entire system. 20
