Under existing law, the Board of Trustees of the University of Alabama is responsible for the

management and control of all campuses of the

University of Alabama System. The board is composed

of two members from each congressional district in

the state, an additional member from the

congressional district which includes the site of

the first campus of the university, the State

Superintendent of Education, and the Governor.

This bill would propose an amendment to Section 264 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended by Amendment 399 to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section 264 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, to provide that the Board of Trustees of the University of Alabama would be composed of individuals who are graduates of the University of Alabama, the University of Alabama at Birmingham, or the University of Alabama in Huntsville.

1 with one member from each of the districts being a graduate of the University of Alabama, one member from each of the 2 districts being a graduate of the University of Alabama at 3 Birmingham, and one member from each of the districts being a graduate of the University of Alabama in Huntsville, an 5 additional member from the congressional district which 6 7 includes the site of the first campus of the university, the superintendent of education, and the governor, who shall be ex 8 officio president of the board. The members of the board of 9 10 trustees as now constituted on the effective date of the 11 ratification of this amendment shall hold office until their 12 respective terms expire under existing law, and until their 13 successors shall be elected and confirmed as hereinafter required. The additional trustees provided for by this 14 15 amendment shall be elected by the existing members of the board, and confirmed by the senate in the manner provided 16 17 below, for initial terms of not more than six years established by the board so that one term shall expire each 18 three years in each congressional district. Successors to the 19 terms of the existing and additional trustees shall hold 20 21 office for a term of six years, and shall not serve more than three consecutive full six-year terms on the board; provided 22 however that a trustee shall retire from the board and vacate 23 24 office at the annual meeting of the board following that trustee's seventieth birthday. Election of additional and 25 26 successor trustees or of trustees to fill any vacancy created 27 by the expiration of a term or by the death or resignation of

any member or from any other cause shall be by the remaining members of the board by secret ballot; provided, that any trustee so elected shall hold office from the date of election until confirmation or rejection by the senate, and, if confirmed, until the expiration of the term for which elected, and until a successor is elected. At every meeting of the legislature the superintendent of education shall certify to the senate the names of all who shall have been so elected since the last session of the legislature, and the senate shall confirm or reject them, as it shall determine is for the best interest of the university. If it rejects the names of any members, it shall thereupon elect trustees in the stead of those rejected. No trustee shall receive any pay or emolument other than his actual expenses incurred in the discharge of his duties as such. Upon the vacation of office by a trustee, the board, if it desires, may be stow upon a trustee the honorary title of trustee emeritus, but such status shall confer no responsibilities, duties, rights, or privileges as such."

Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment shall be held in accordance with Sections 284 and 285 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Sections 284 and 285 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this state.

Section 3. The appropriate election official shall assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional

amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the 1 2 following description of the substance or subject matter of 3 the proposed constitutional amendment: "Proposing an amendment to Section 264, as amended by Amendment 399, of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, 5 relating to the Board of Trustees of the University of 6 7 Alabama; to provide that the Board of Trustees of the University of Alabama would be composed of individuals who are 8 graduates of the University of Alabama, the University of 9 10 Alabama at Birmingham, or the University of Alabama in 11 Huntsville. "Proposed by Act ____." 12 This description shall be followed by the following 13 14 language: "Yes () No ()." 15
