ENROLLED, An Act,

To alter or rearrange the boundary lines of the City of Alexander City, Tallapoosa County, Alabama, so as to include within the corporate limits of said City all territory now within such corporate limits and also certain other territory contiguous thereto, in Alexander City, Tallapoosa County, Alabama.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. That the boundary lines of the City of Alexander City, Tallapoosa County, Alabama, be, and the same are hereby altered or rearranged so as to include all of the territory heretofore encompassed by the corporate limits of the City of Alexander City, and in addition thereto the following described territory, to-wit:

IN TOWNSHIP 23 NORTH, RANGE 21 EAST, TALLAPOOSA COUNTY, ALABAMA

- All of Section 28 not currently in city limits.
- All of Section 29 not currently in city limits.
- All of Section 32 not currently in city limits.
- All of Section 33 not currently in city limits.
- All of Section 34 not currently in city limits.
- All of Section 35 not currently in city limits.

IN TOWNSHIP 22 NORTH, RANGE 21 EAST, TALLAPOOSA COUNTY, ALABAMA.

1 All of Section 1 not currently in city limits.

9 Section 2. A map showing the territory proposed to
10 be annexed is on file in the Dadeville and Alexander City,
11 Alabama offices of the Judge of Probate in Tallapoosa County.

14 Clerk's office at the Alexander City City Hall.

15 Section 3. This Act shall become effective upon its
16 passage and approval by the Governor, or upon its otherwise
17 becoming a law.
