1 To propose an amendment to Section 264 of the 2 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended by Amendment 399 to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as 3 4 Section 264 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, relating to the University of 5 Alabama Board of Trustees; to rename the board as the Board of 6 7 Trustees of the University of Alabama System; to revise the makeup of the board to include additional members from areas 8 9 of the state in which a campus of the university system is 10 located; to decrease the number of consecutive six-year terms 11 of office a member may serve from three to two; and to specify 12 where the office for the system and the chancellor of the 13 system may be located. 14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA: Section 1. The following amendment to the 15 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, is proposed and 16 17 shall become valid as a part thereof when approved by a majority of the qualified electors voting thereon and in 18 accordance with Sections 284, 285, and 287 of the Constitution 19 of Alabama of 1901, as amended: 20 21 PROPOSED AMENDMENT 22 "Section 264. "(a) The University of Alabama System shall 23

24 <u>constitute a public corporation and instrumentality of the</u>
25 <u>state.</u> The state university <u>University of Alabama System</u> shall
26 be under the management and control of a board of trustees,
27 which shall consist of.

1	" <u>(b) The University of Alabama System Board of</u>
2	Trustees shall be comprised of all of the following members:
3	" <u>(1) Two</u> members from each congressional
4	district in the state, an additional member from the
5	congressional district which includes the site of the first
6	campus of the university, the superintendent of education, and
7	the governor.
8	" <u>(2) One member from each congressional district in</u>
9	the state in which a campus of the university system is
10	located.
11	" <u>(3) One member who is appointed by majority vote of</u>
12	the governing body of any municipality in which a campus of
13	the university system is located.
14	" <u>(4) One member who is appointed by majority vote of</u>
15	the governing body of any county in which a campus of the

17	" <u>(5) One member representing the alumni of each</u>

19	Governor from a list of five names submitted by each of the
20	respective campus alumni associations.
21	" <u>(6) One member from the state at-large who is</u>

26	appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate.

"(10) The Governor, who shall be ex officio

3 "(c) The members of the board of trustees as now
4 constituted <u>on the ratification date of this amendment</u> shall
5 hold office until their respective terms expire under existing
6 law, and until their successors shall be elected and confirmed
7 as hereinafter required.

8 "(d) The members of the board of trustees appointed
9 pursuant to subdivisions (1), (2), and (5) of subsection (b)
10 shall be subject to confirmation by the Senate.

11 "(e) The additional trustees provided for by this 12 amendment shall be elected by the existing members of the 13 board, and confirmed by the senate in the manner provided 14 below, appointed for initial terms of not more than that are 15 staggered to expire over the course of six years established 16 by the board so that one term shall expire each three years in 17 each congressional district.

"(f) Successors to the terms of the existing and 18 additional trustees shall hold office for a term of six years, 19 and shall not serve more than three two consecutive full 20 21 six-year terms on the board. ; provided however that a trustee 22 shall retire from the board and vacate office at the annual 23 meeting of the board following that trustee's seventieth 24 birthday. Election of additional and successor trustees or of 25 trustees to fill any vacancy created by the expiration of a 26 term or by the death or resignation of any member or from any 27 other cause shall be by the remaining members of the board by

1	secret ballot; provided, that any trustee so elected shall
2	hold office from the date of election until confirmation or
3	rejection by the senate, and, if confirmed, until the
4	expiration of the term for which elected, and until a
5	successor is elected. At every meeting of the legislature the
б	superintendent of education shall certify to the senate the
7	names of all who shall have been so elected since the last
8	session of the legislature, and the senate shall confirm or
9	reject them, as it shall determine is for the best interest of
10	the university. If it rejects the names of any members, it
11	shall thereupon elect trustees in the stead of those rejected.
12	"(g)(1) A board of trustees appointing committee is
13	established composed of the following members:
14	"a. The president pro tem of the board of trustees.
15	"b. One member of each alumni association of the
16	system selected by the board of trustees of each alumni
17	association.
18	"c. The Governor, or a designee of the Governor, who
19	is not a current employee of the University of Alabama System
20	or any of the institutions therein.
21	"(2) The Governor, or the designee of the Governor,
22	shall serve as chair of the appointing committee. If the chair
23	fails to call a meeting within 90 days before the expiration
24	of the term of a sitting board member or within 30 days after
25	the creation of a vacancy by death, resignation, or other
26	cause, a majority of the committee, in writing, may call a
27	meeting giving at least 10 days' notice. In the absence of the

<u>chair or another member designated by the chair to preside, a</u>
 <u>majority of the committee shall choose its own chair.</u>

3 "(3) When appropriate, the appointing committee
4 shall meet to address the appointment of any vacancy of a
5 trustee serving pursuant to subdivision (1) or subdivision (2)
6 of subsection (b).

7 "(4) The appointing committee, by majority vote,
8 shall appoint an individual to fill the respective position on
9 the board of trustees. The committee shall ensure that
10 appointments are solicited from all constituencies, are
11 inclusive, and reflect the racial, gender, and economic
12 diversity of the state.

"(h) No trustee shall receive any pay or emolument
other than his <u>or her</u> actual expenses incurred in the
discharge of his duties as such. Upon the vacation of office
by a trustee, the board, if it desires, may bestow upon a
trustee the honorary title of trustee emeritus, but such
status shall confer no responsibilities, duties, rights, or
privileges as such.

20 "(i) The office of the University of Alabama System
21 and that of the Chancellor of the University of Alabama
22 System, should a chancellor be employed, shall be located in
23 the largest municipality within a county in which a campus of
24 the university system is located."

Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment
shall be held in accordance with Sections 284 and 285 of the
Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Sections 284

and 285 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of
 Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this
 state.

Section 3. The appropriate election official shall
assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional
amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the
following description of the substance or subject matter of
the proposed constitutional amendment:

"Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of 9 10 Alabama of 1901, relating to the Board of Trustees of the University of Alabama; to rename the board as the Board of 11 12 Trustees of the University of Alabama System; to revise the 13 makeup of the board to include additional members from areas 14 of the state in which a campus of the university system is 15 located; to decrease the number of consecutive six-year terms of office a member may serve from three to two; and to specify 16 17 where the office for the system and the chancellor of the system may be located. 18
