26	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. (a) So long as the University of Alabama

System maintains an intercollegiate football program at the

Tuscaloosa campus, the system must also maintain an

intercollegiate football program at the Birmingham campus.

- (b) The intercollegiate football program maintained at the Birmingham campus shall be funded at an appropriate level to participate in the Football Bowl Series Division, or its successor.
- (c) It shall not be a requirement that the football program participate in a Power 5 Conference, but shall at the university's option participate in the same conference as all other intercollegiate sports offered at the university.

Section 2. It is the intent of the Legislature that constitutionally created boards of trustees fully comply with the requirements of this section.

Section 3. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
