Relating to Mobile County; to provide for the transfer of all duties, responsibilities, and liabilities regarding real estate sales for failure to pay taxes and any subsequent redemptions from the judge of probate to the revenue commissioner.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

9 Section 1. This act shall apply only in Mobile 10 County.

Section 2. All duties, responsibilities, and liabilities regarding real property sales for failure to pay taxes and any subsequent redemption heretofore performed by the judge of probate shall be transferred to and shall be performed by the revenue commissioner.

Section 3. All laws or parts of laws which conflict with this act are repealed.

Section 4. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
